

Sector SPDRs & Sector iShares

When selecting a sector ETF, it's important to consider more than just the underlying portfolio. Factors such as total assets, trading volume, and bid/offer spread are key to understanding the total cost of ownership.

The underlying portfolios of Sector SPDRs and iShares are similar. Although their components are not identical, both are market-capitalization weighted and designed to provide exposure to a specific sector. Because of this, they are highly correlated.
